You will need to complete and return the application form with high quality images of your product/business & current public liability insurance policy certificate.

Fine Print

Applications close 5 days prior to each market and will be chosen by the SCCM panel. Acceptance is via a competitive process according to originality and suitability of designs & concepts in line with the SCCM. Invoices will be sent out prior to market day. Your Booking is confirmed once payment is received. All stallholders & food vendors must provide a public liability insurance policy.

All stallholders must provide their own marquees and setup shop like a boss. Presentation will be a focus at SCCM. But I don't need to tell you that – you are awesome!

Non – Attendance after you have made payment:
If you are unable to attend the Market you have paid for, please notify us before 5pm on the Friday prior to the Sunday Market and we will transfer your stall holder payment to the following SCCM. Failure to provide us with this notice will result in forfeiting your payment.

Trading Hours:

You will have access to your stall from 7am on Market day and trading will commence at 8.30am. Pack up will commence at 12.30pm and you are to vacate the your market site by 1.30pm at the latest. Trading hours may change due to market demand but you will be given 4 weeks notice. Stall Holders who have not occupied their stall by this time may forfeit their stall booking & will not be entitled to a refund or any credit of stall fees and the SCCM Managers reserve the right to allocate the stall to another stall holder.

SCCM Cancellation:

Cancellation of an SCCM day will only be considered in extreme weather circumstances. Where the weather prevents a SCCM from opening – all of the Stall Fee will be transferred to the next consecutive SCCM. However, Stallholders will not be entitled to any compensation or penalty in the case of cancellation regardless of whether any notice has been given.

Approved Products:

A new application form must be submitted & approved for any products that vary from original approval. This application will be reviewed and the stallholder will be advised as to whether the product has been approved for sale or not. The SCCM Manager may cancel a stallholder's approval to occupy a SCCM stall if the items offered for sale are substantially different to the Approved Product or is of poor quality/does not meet approved criteria.

Parking & Traffic Control:

Stallholders must abide by the instructions of the SCCM Management & staff regarding the movement and parking of vehicles at the Market.

Waste Management:

SCCM Stall holders must remove all garbage, waste, litter and other rubbish that the stallholder has either brought with them or obtained at the Market with them upon departure. At the end of the day's trading, the stallholder is responsible for leaving their site as they found it – clear of all rubbish and waste.
